Some things to consider when communicating through social media

Nothing is private. Consider what you share online as if you posted it on a bulletin board on a public wall. No matter how secure or obscure the site, consider it public information.

Some suggestions to edify one another and protect reputations and relationships when using social media

As members of Christ's body, we represent Him: as members of All Saints' Childwall we represent our Church. Therefore, ask yourself before you post anything, "Will what I say honour God?" and do not post comments or materials others may consider offensive, abusive or demeaning, or would dishonour God in any way.

Think: Is what I say True? Helpful? Inspirational? Necessary? Kind?
